






#### More than half of the population live in 3 provinces (GP,KZN and WC)






# KZN has close to 35% of children under 15 whilst Gauteng has the highest proportion of Youth and Adults (15-59)

Population by age category and province, 2020










#### 41,8% of Female headed households in KZN do not have an employed household member








### **KZN Money-metric Poverty headcounts in 2015**








The South African Multidimensional Poverty indicators provide a more holistic view of poverty












# KZN had higher levels of multidimensional poverty than the SA average over the three periods


Multidimensional Poverty by Geographic Various levels 2001-2016











Percentage distribution of sources of household income by province, 2019








## In 2019 KZN surpassed the national average in households connected to mains electricity with 86,7%

Women are amongst these groups








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
## KZN has the third highest proportion of agricultural households at 18,6% within the province







#### Of the 3 districts King Cetshwayo had the highest rate of Femaleheaded households that are likely to run out of money to buy food at 34,4%








# At 15,6% KZN has the second highest percentage of female headed households that reported suffering from hunger


## Gender pay gap examined, findings from the Quarterly Labour Force Survey






# In 2018 women's median monthly earnings were 76% of men's median monthly earnings



Experience of violence by any partner, women 18+ years




