BACKGROUND

Mpumalanga has seventy-one (71) registered taxi associations broken down as follows: Ehlanzeni district twenty (20), Gert Sibande twenty-eight (28) and twenty-three (23) Nkangala District. Twenty Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty Three (24 933) taxi vehicles registered and almost nine thousand seven hundred and seventy six (9776) active members registered.





BACKGROUND CONTINUED

The Department is also managing seven (7) bus contracts.

No PPEs were supplied to bus contractors. They provided sanitizers to passengers at their own expense.





PPE's RECEIVED

The department received Personal Protective Equipment (PPE's) for the Mpumalanga Public Transport Industry on the 6th of April 2020 from Department of Transport (DoT) as an intervention to contain the spread of the corona virus.
