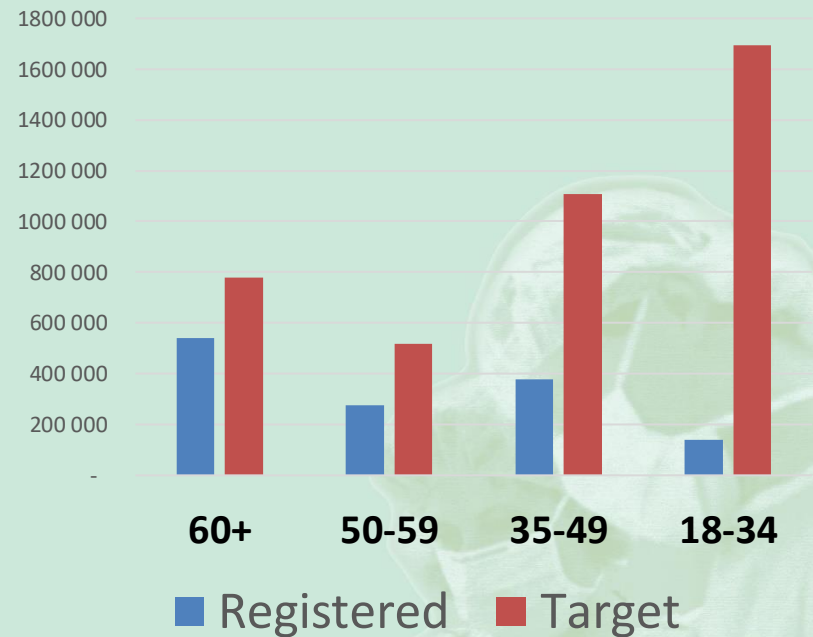

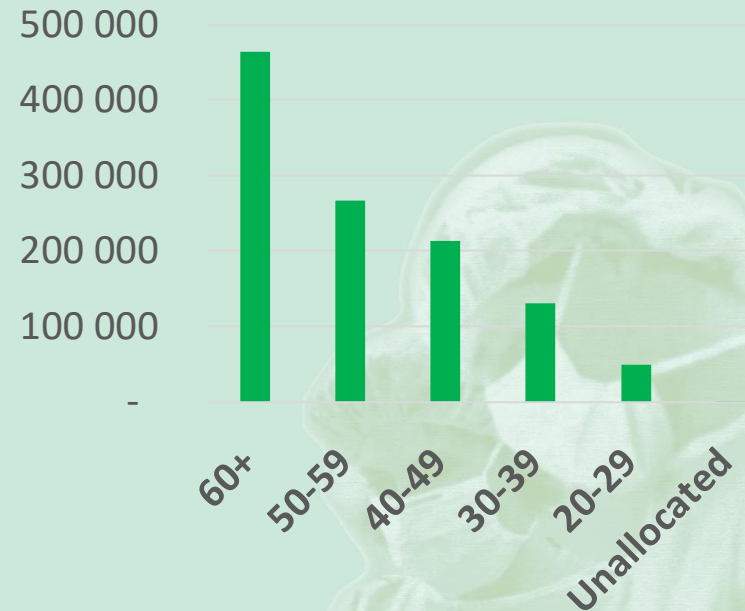

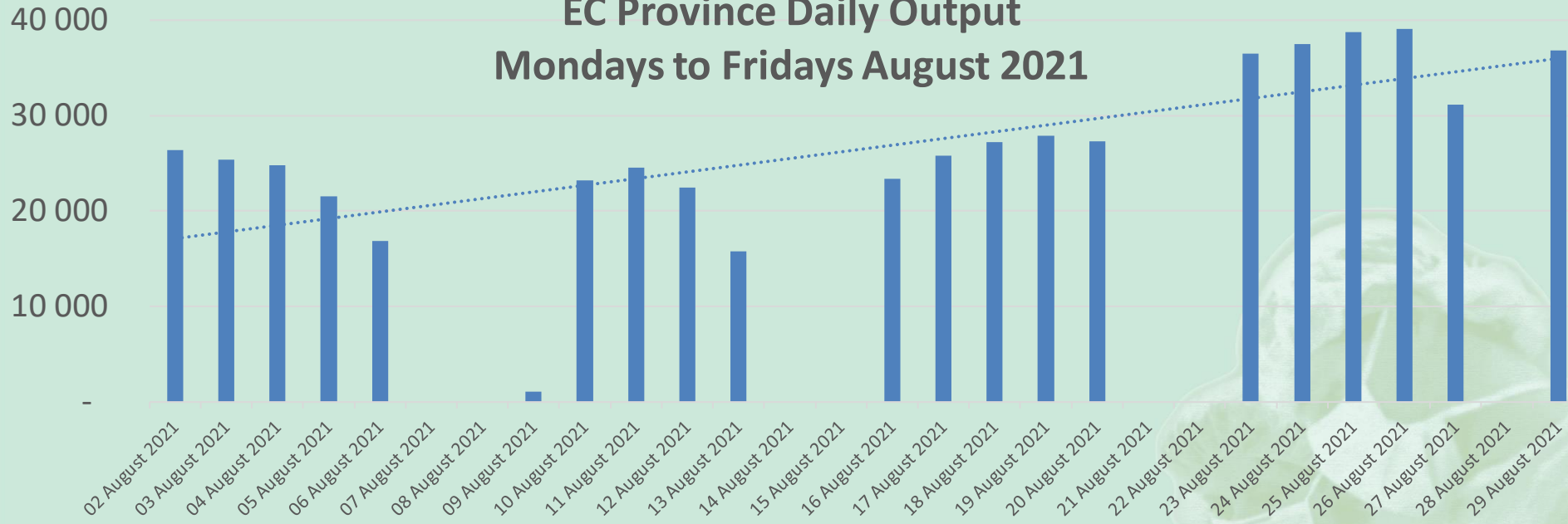
## Individuals Vaccinated by Age Group

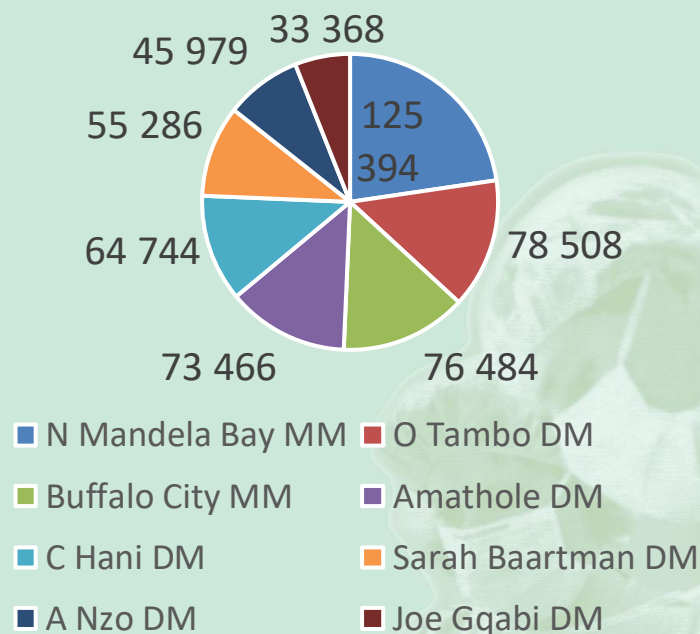

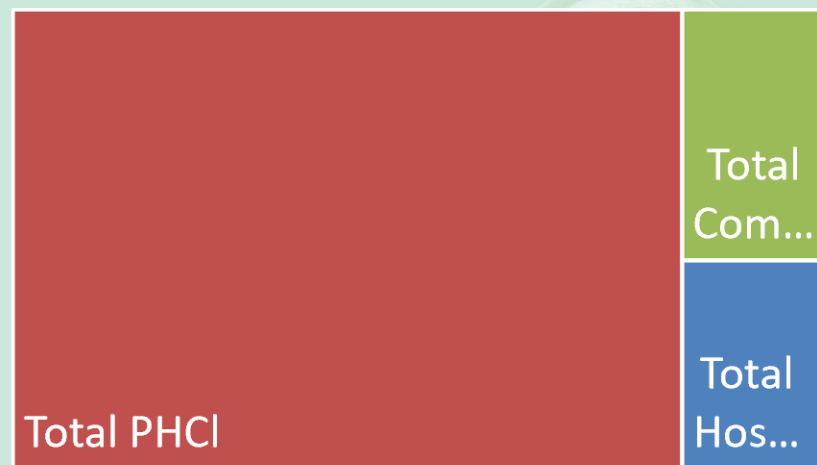

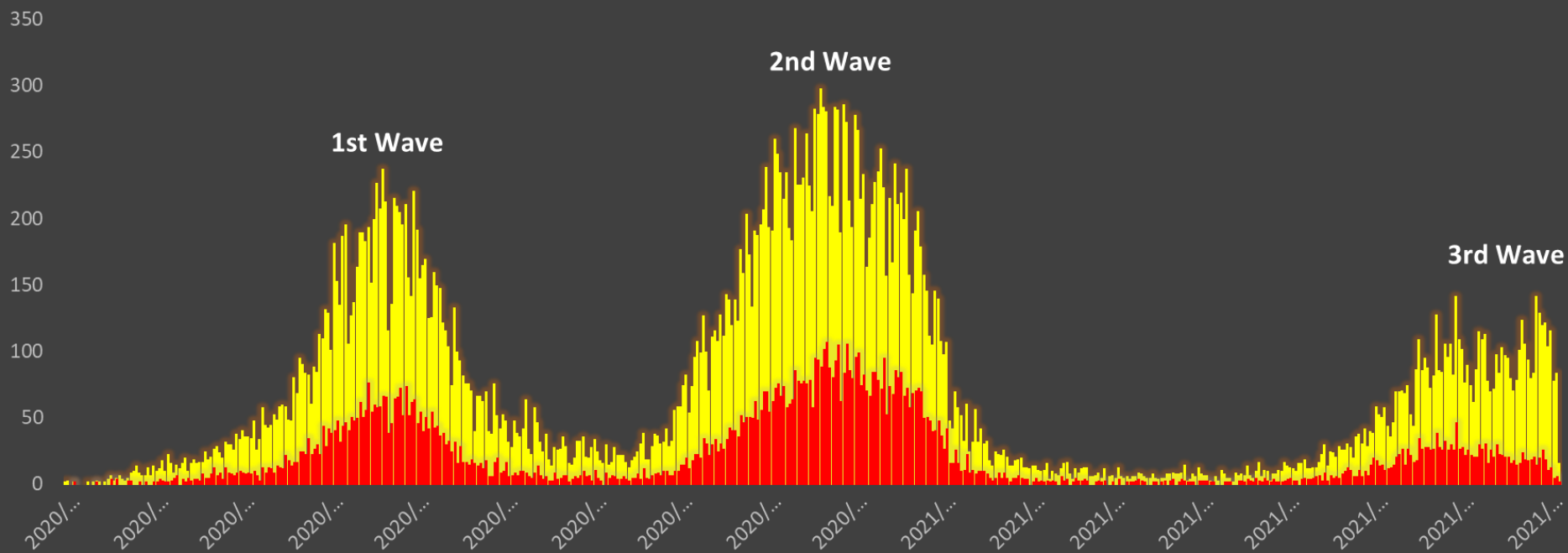

■ Hospital Admissions ■ Deaths





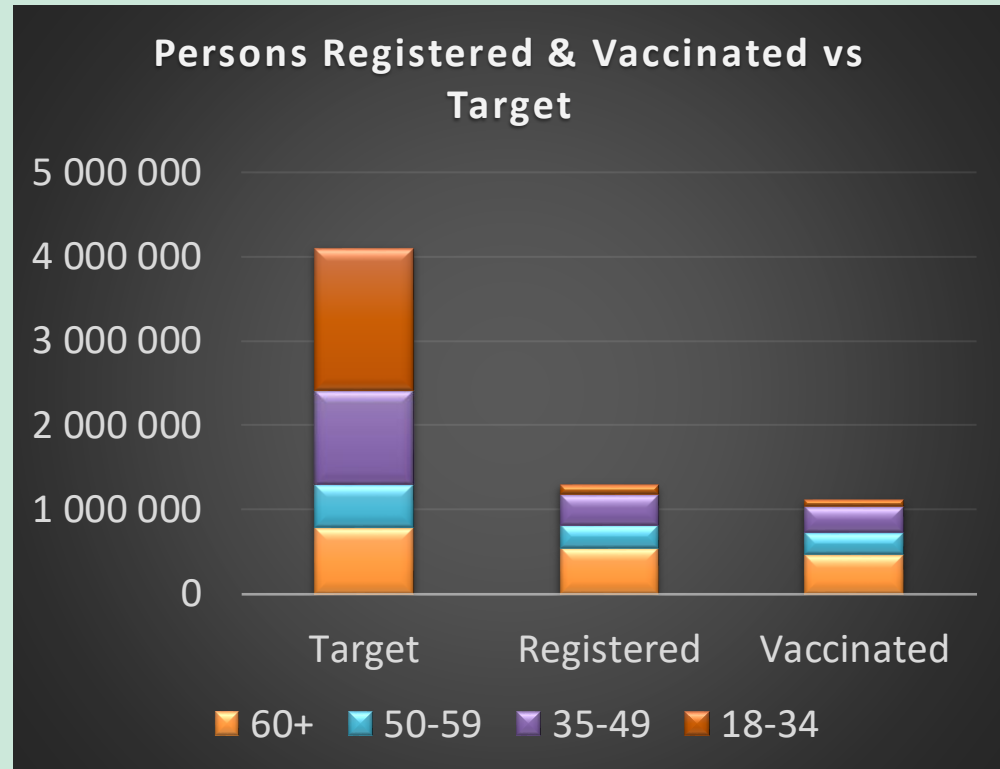
# DIFFERENTIATED APPROACH



# TARGETING YOUTH

The Province has got **925 schools with learners 18years and above:**

- **DOE has availed Vaccination sites** that were used by education sector employees
- **Clustering of schools** where there are bigger is planned to be used as temporal vaccination sites
- **Scheduling of learners** to fixed sites is being done to avoid congestion
- **Districts are conducting outreach to TVET Colleges and to the schools that are, 5-7.5km** away from the vaccination site .
- **Universities** have been activated as **Temporal outreach vaccination sites**
- **Weekend sites** are activated to target learners from the Schools and TVET colleges including the general population
- **O.R.Tambo:** On the 24<sup>th</sup>/8/2021 to 25/8/2021 an **outreach programme** was conducted to **Tsolo Agricultural College;** Outreach will be conducted to **Walter Sisulu University** on the 1<sup>st</sup>/9/2021 to 3<sup>rd</sup> /9/2021



## REGISTRATION for COVID-19 VACCINATION 18yrs+

- Don't have an ID yet?
- You can use your **BIRTH CERTIFICATE** that has an **ID NUMBER** to register.
- If your birth certificate does not have an **ID NUMBER**, you will not be able to register now.

**Please register in October when the EVDS System will be open to people without ID numbers.**

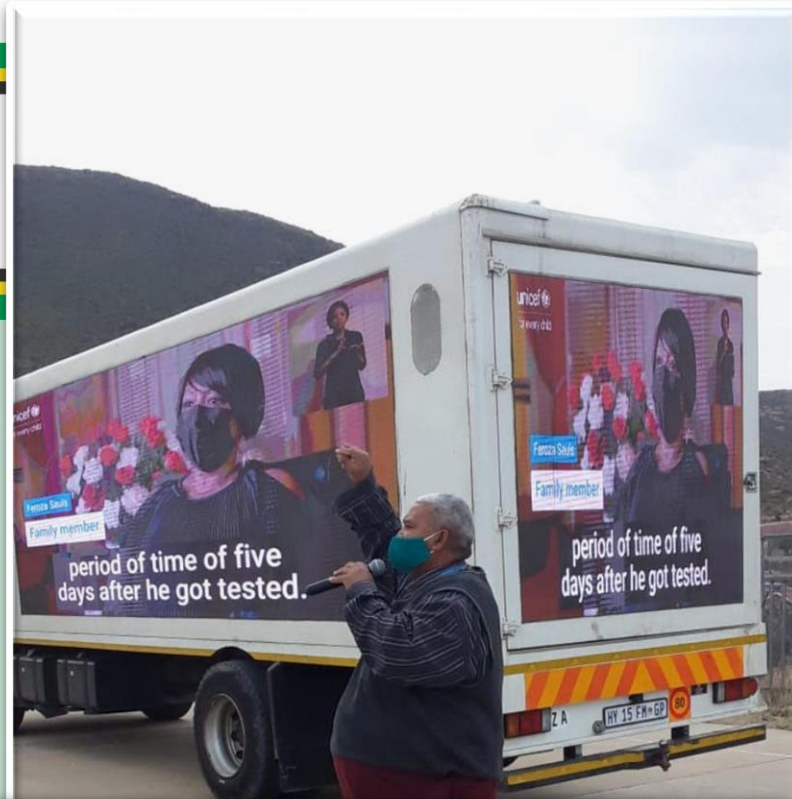

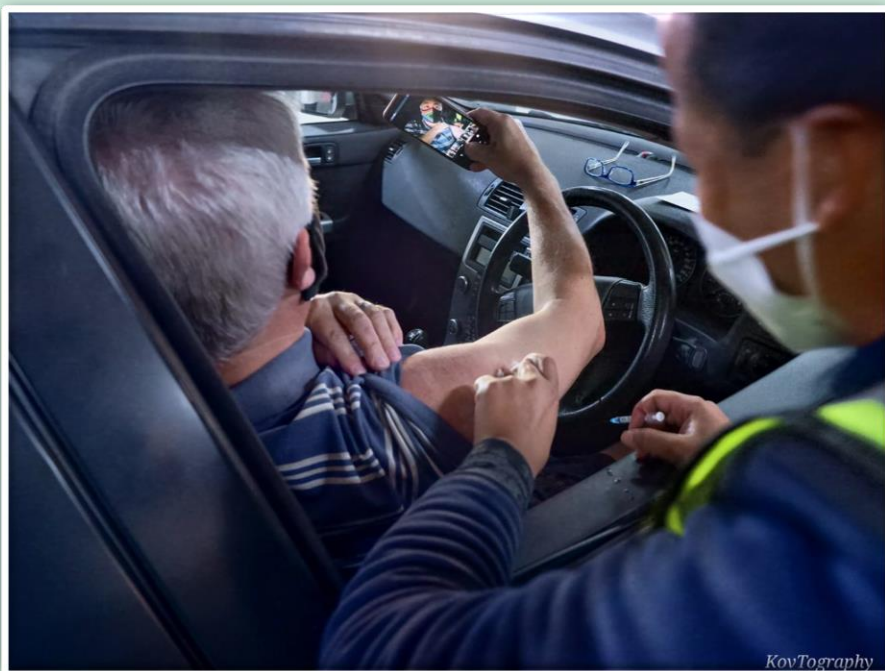

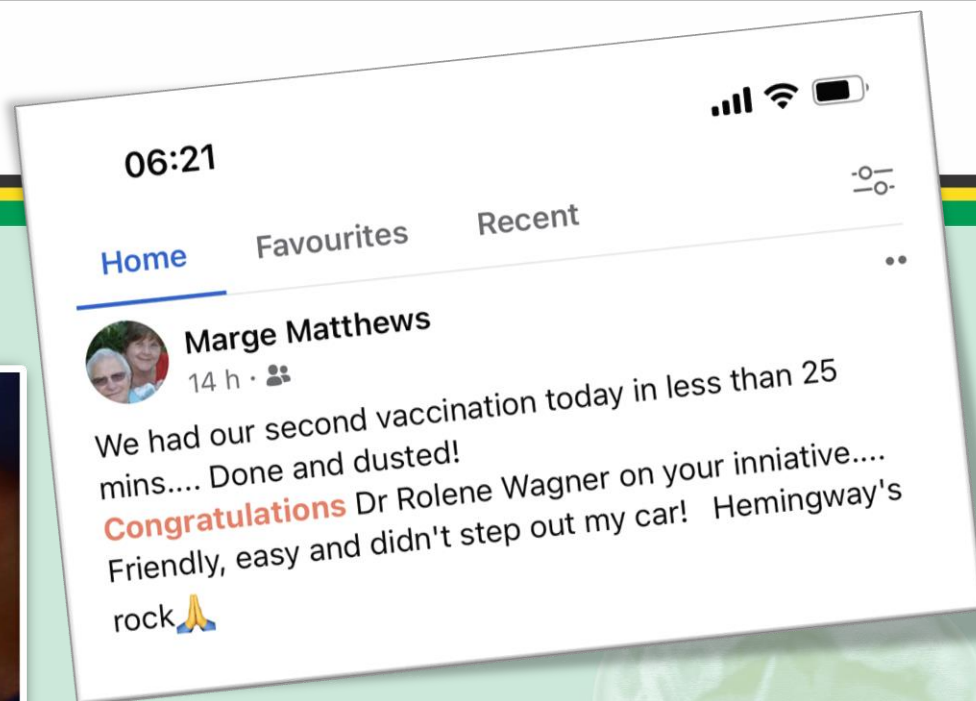
