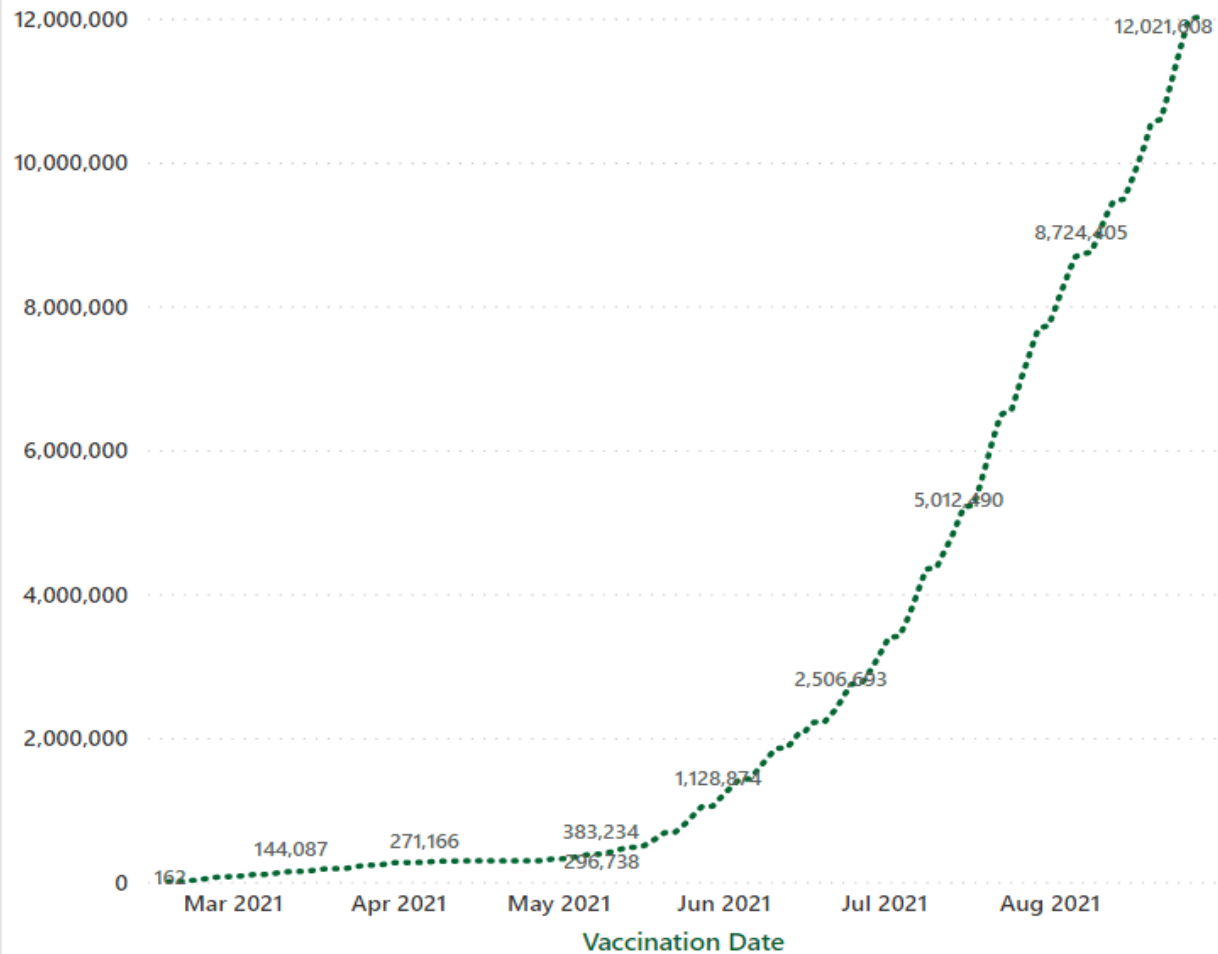

Vaccine doses administered in South Africa 29/8/2021

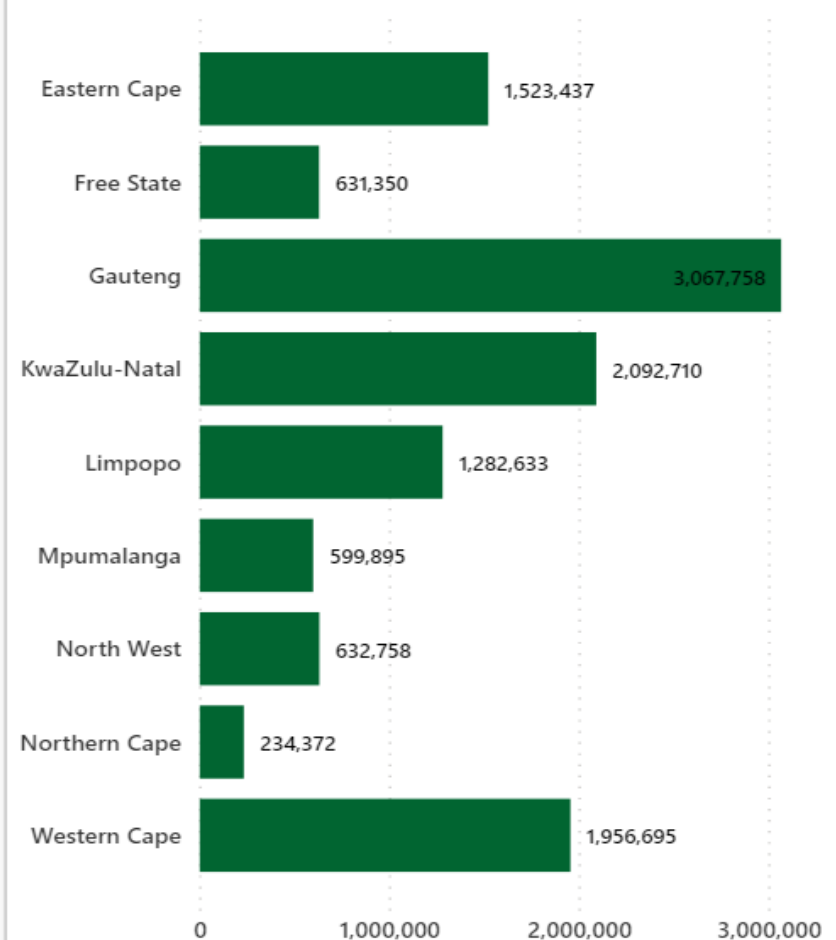

General vaccination progress by 29/08/2021

- Vaccination coverage against target population North West Province is 18.2 %
- 80.69 % of all registered persons have vaccinated
- Highest vaccination rate against registered in Dr KK and RSM Districts

Age based Population targets

- The Population of North West Province = 4.1 million
- Population targeted to achieve population immunity = 2.7 million
- Age band 18-34 years =1.28 million
- Age band 35-49 years =731642
- Age band 50-59 years =342679
- Age band >60 years =367553

Vaccination sites progress

- 8 sites used for phase 1 vaccination (7 public and 1 Private)
- 55 sites used in phase 2 vaccination (42 public and 13 Private)
- More than 200 temporary clinical and non clinical out reach sites set up and being used
- Process underway to establish 8 mass vaccination sites (3-Bojanala, 2 Ngaka Modiri Molema, 2 Kenneth Kaunda and 1 Ruth Segomotsi Mompati)
- Two sites established at North West University Potchefstroom and Mafikeng Campuses
- Sun City Super Bowl vaccination site in Bojanala activated on 24th July 2021 for OHS stream converted to mass vaccination site from 21/8/2021
- Jade Square mass vaccination site in Klerksdorp started operating on 04 August 2021
- Expanded Vaccination at SASSA points –National project funded by Solidarity fund and run by partners (Pulse Health, AURUM and NHLS) at 8 pop up sites

Strategies to ramp up registration and vaccination

1. Increasing vaccination sites progressively to 70 Public and 22 Private Sector Sites
2. Establishing a total 8 mass/large vaccination sites in the Province
3. Intensified campaigns to improve registration through deployment of registration teams to Local Municipality wards, establishing stations at strategic areas where people congregate, house to house registrations and registration at all health facilities
4. Strengthening mobile outreach vaccination programme
5. Shared resources with mines, municipalities, academic institutions, businesses
6. Engagement with religious sector for increased reach to the congregants
7. Involvement of Traditional Authorities, Health Councils and Local Authorities to mobilise communities for vaccination
8. Contracting additional personnel (735) at a cost of R 136,181,668
9. Securing sufficient information management and communication technology equipment

Communication strategy

- Media Interviews led by the Honourable Premier and Members of Executive Committee
- Installation of Billboards sharing information on vaccination
- Distribution of Pamphlets and Posters
- Television Round-Table Discussions on Vaccination rollout in the Province
- Media Coverage of Outreach deployment of Members of Command Council
- Coverage of Vaccination Launches on television, radio and Social media
- Coverage of Social Media Counteracting rumours and misinformation
- Regular pod casts to share vaccination programme

Specific readiness for age band 18-34 years

- Intensified Communication directed to target the young adults using appropriate channels including social media, podcasts, posters
- Involvement of young celebrities and influencers
- Setting up registration and vaccination sites at strategic points including institutions of higher learning, malls, libraries
- Involvement of the partner sectors that host this age group such as Universities, Department of Higher Education, TVET colleges, local businesses and hospitality industry
- Considering appropriate incentives such as branded T shirts, caps, masks, bags, discount at stores
- All 42 public and 13 private vaccination sites opened for this age band
- vaccination done for this age group over weekends at 22 sites

Sub District and Ward based activities to ramp up vaccination

- Age and gender specific demand creation and communication using Vaccine ambassadors and influencers
- Strengthen at the communication strategy to impart knowledge and overcome negative perceptions about the vaccine
- Use all available print material, social and media platforms
- Each sub district utilizing Red Cross cadres to communicate and register citizens
- Registration of all patients and visitors attending health facilities
- Registration and vaccination sites in shopping centres and malls (Matlosana, Mooi Rivier, Market Square, Water fall, Rustenburg, Brits Platinum, Moruleng, Taung) from 1 September 2021 and other areas where people congregate:
- Vaccination of the elderly using mobile vehicles at their homes.
- House to House registration and vaccination for those not mobile
- Ward based, effectively advertised and mobilized outreach vaccination programmes using CHWs, Red cross tracers, Assisted registration teams
- Engage religious formations (SAMIFRA , SACC) and vaccinate at churches/mosques/temples/synagogues

Sub District and Ward based activities to ramp up vaccination

- Engage cultural groups in mobilization efforts: Youth formations and clubs
- Proper signage of the vaccination sites
- Publicize vaccination sites and vaccination schedule
- Do scheduling and allow onsite registration and vaccination (Walk ins)
- Consider incentives for vaccination (Branded T shirts, masks, bags, discount at stores)
- Engage all stakeholders willing to assist(volunteers) to mobilize and vaccinate
- Donation of computers for each district by sister departments for IT support for the vaccination drive
- Enhanced vaccination Marketing and Branding
