#### 1. Introduction of Bills

##### (1) Dr S S Thembekwayo, MP

- (a) **National Health Amendment Bill** [B 29 - 2018] (National Assembly – proposed sec 76) [Explanatory summary of Bill and prior notice of its introduction published in *Government Gazette* No. 41657 of 25 May 2018.]

Introduction and referral to the **Portfolio Committee on Health** of the National Assembly, as well as referral to the Joint Tagging Mechanism (JTM) for classification in terms of Joint Rule 160.

In terms of Joint Rule 154 written views on the classification of the Bill may be submitted to the JTM. The Bill may only be classified after the expiry of at least three parliamentary working days since introduction.

#### 2. Membership of Committees

- (1) Dr Mathole Motshekga has been elected as the Co-chairperson of the Joint Standing Committee on the Financial Management of Parliament representing the National Assembly with effect from 04 September 2018.

#### 3. Bills not passed

- (1) The following Bills have been rejected by the National Assembly on 4 September 2018:
- (a) **Expropriation Bill** [B 4D – 2015], in terms of Joint Rule 203(3)(c) (*see* Minutes of Proceedings of National Assembly of 4 September 2018).
- (b) **Choice on Termination of Pregnancy Amendment Bill** [B 34 – 2017], in terms of Assembly Rule 290(6) (*see* Minutes of Proceedings of National Assembly of 4 September 2018).
