- (1) A letter, dated 7 August 2019, has been received from the Chairperson of the Public Service Commission, requesting the Assembly to expedite the President's request, made in terms of section 4 (1) of the Public Service Commission Act, 1997 (Act No 46 of 1997), and tabled and referred to the Portfolio Committee on Public Service and Administration on 2 April 2019, that it initiates the process to fill a vacancy when the term of office of Ms SS Nkosi came to an end on 23 April 2019. Referred to the **Portfolio Committee on Public Service and Administration**.
