### SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION

#### *Knowledge-based systems*

- ★90. **Mr M F Mokwele (Limpopo: ANC) to ask the Minister of Science, Technology and Innovation:**

How is his department utilising knowledge-based systems to contribute to economic growth initiatives in line with the National Development Plan of South Africa? CO280E

#### *Misuse of artificial intelligence*
