### *Implementation of Defence Review*

- (1) Whether, following the approval of the SA Defence Review by Cabinet on 20 March 2014 and by the National Assembly on 4 June 2015 and the National Council of Provinces on 25 June 2015, any measures have been taken to direct the implementation of such a review in the Department of Defence; if not, why not; if so, (a) what measures and (b) what are the further relevant details;
- (2) whether the National Treasury was consulted on such implementation; if not, why not; if so, (a) what was the nature of such consultation and (b) what was the outcome thereof? CO961E

### *Operational readiness of SAAF*
