Short-/long-term interventions

★1. Ms L C Dlamini (Mpumalanga: ANC) to ask the Deputy President:

Whether the Government has developed short- and long-term interventions of ensuring that the State strengthen good governance in the public service and state-owned entities in order to enhance the delivery of quality services and strengthening state entities (details furnished); if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

Alleged criminal activities at SOEs

★2. Mr O S Terblanche (Western Cape: DA) to ask the Deputy President:

(1) Whether he has taken any steps to stop the alleged criminal activities and prevent further looting and stealing of state funds at state-owned enterprises as the Chairperson of the Inter-Ministerial Committee on State-owned Enterprise Reform (details furnished); if not, why not; if so, what steps;

(2) whether any criminal cases have been opened with (a) the police and/or (b) other institutions in the past three financial years; if not, why not; if so, what progress has been made in this regard to date?

Programmes with deliverable outcomes

★3. Ms T Motara (Gauteng: ANC) to ask the Deputy President:

(1) Whether, in light of the population profile of the country, the Government has any programmes with deliverable outcomes to address challenges that are facing the youth; if not, why not; if so, what programmes;

(2) whether the programmes include measures to ensure a coordinated approach to enhance the active role of young people in the developmental path and objectives as outlined in the National Development Plan, particularly in finding lasting solutions for addressing youth poverty and unemployment; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (2) whether the Government intends to implement the introduction of added regulations over the religious sector as recommended by the Commission for the Promotion and Protection of the Rights of Cultural, Religious and Linguistic Communities; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

Whether he has started conducting a lifestyle audit of the National Executive as instructed by the President in the State-of-Nation-Address of 2018; if not, (a) why not and (b) when will he begin the process; if so, what are the relevant details? CO148E

Expropriation of land without compensation

★6. Mr B G Nthebe (North West: ANC) to ask the Deputy President:

- (1) Whether the Government had any engagements with Traditional Leaders on the expropriation of land without compensation; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (2) whether the engagements included fostering a shared understanding on the ownership and usage of communal land; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether the Government is considering any policy or legislative interventions to give clarity to the acquisition, ownership and usage of communal land, especially in light of the concerns around the sale of communal land to the private sector by Chiefs without engagement and benefit to communities; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?
