The Committee is thus mandated by the Constitution to consider legislation affecting the Department, conduct oversight over the Department and its 126 Missions abroad and facilitate public participation in South Africa's international activities. The Committee may also investigate any matter of public interest that falls within the foreign policy area of responsibility. The Committee is thus an important mechanism for ensuring oversight over the conduct of South Africa's international relations and cooperation policy.</p>
