




The Parliament Graduate Development

providing opportunities for newly qualified
graduates to gain valuable work experience in the various
vocational areas available within Parliament.

Learning opportunities are offered for graduates with the following minimum required qualifications:

- LLB
- B degree in Computer Science, Informatics or Information Systems/Technology
- B degree in Facility Management or B Tech: Project Management
- Diploma: Food & Beverage Management
- Diploma: Professional Cookery
- B Degree in Curatorship/Heritage Management or related field
- Masters in Economics (Macroeconomics)
- Masters in Public Policy or Public Finance
- BSC Electrical Engineering Light Current or Electronic Engineering
- Bachelor's Degree in Graphic Design or Motion Graphics
- B degree in Internal Audit







During the programme, you will be offered continuous, intensive training to grow professionally and develop your skills for a career in the legislative sector, mentored by a seasoned, senior employee to ensure that you meet your personal and career goals.

- STEP ONE: Register Your Profile on the iRecruitment System here
- . STEP TWO: Update All Your Required Personal Information, Work Experience and Upload All Necessary Certified Supporting Documentation (Qualification Certificate/s, ID, CV etc.)

- Select **EXTERNAL APPLICANTS** and Register your profile on the iRecruitment system.
- You will be required to update your profile with all the relevant and necessary information relating to your personal particulars, documenting your work experience, qualifications and skills acquired. Please attach certified copies of all your qualification certificates, academic transcripts and ID. Applicants must ensure that all required documents are attached. Apply for the position of interest and follow the prompts on the system.
- Ensure you complete the assessment.
- Click FINISH. Parliament reserves the right not to make an appointment. All appointments are subject to relevant security clearance and qualification checks.

Important to Note: Successful candidates will be required to sign a 3 year Graduate Trainee contract. Acceptance into the programme is conditional on the applicant obtaining their qualification. All positions are based in Cape Town.
