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






EASTERN CAPE COVID-19 VACCINATION BACKGROUND

- A 3 Phased Approach to vaccinate the 4.5 million people in EC over the age of 18 years has been adopted
- To achieve herd or population immunity, ECDoH must immunise a minimum of 67% of the population over 18
- The minimum target population for vaccination is 3 874 626 persons with an optimal target of 4 497 224 million
- In Phase 1 60,000 of the 200,00
 Health care workers are in the EC
 Public Sector with over 65% interfacing
 with patients
- Targeted vaccination of matriculants at phase 3 to ramp up the numbers












GOVERNANCE & LEADERSHIP

- The OTP is responsible for coordinating all government departments with frontline workers, the business community, civil society
- The Vaccination Task team has representation from the Expanded Programme for Immunisation (EPI), Communicable Disease Cluster (CDC), Pharmaceutical, Supply Chain Management (SCM), Information Systems, Human Resources for Health (HRH), Primary Health Care (PHC), Monitoring and evaluation, Academic institutions, Supporting Partners, Hospital Association, General Practitioners
- The Vaccination Task Team reports weekly to the PDOC and through the PDOC, fortnightly to the PCC





VACCINATION PROGRAMME WORKSTREAMS

PHASE 1 VACCINATION PROGRESS (1)

- Since the change from AstraZeneca vaccine to JnJ, Phase 1 in the EC is being done under strict research conditions:
 - As such vaccination of healthcare workers under Phase 1 is currently being done at 2 sites in the EC (NMAH & Livingstone Hospital)
 - First batch of healthcare workers were vaccinated in the EC on 17 Feb 2021
 - As at 23 Feb 2021, in the 2 EC sites:
 - o 1 687 have been vaccinated
- To improve uptake of vaccination esp in the NMAH site,
 - Provide 6 additional consulting rooms for vaccinators & computers for data capturers
 - Obtaining details of HCW with issued vouchers and follow them up for vaccination





PHASE 1 VACCINATION PROGRESS (2)

- Engage HCWs in immediate neighbouring site (MRH) & encourage them to register for vaccination
- Engage with the private sector HCW and encourage them to come for vaccination
- Dept is also working on logistics for the NMAH site to open over weekends









PREPARATIONS – PHASE 2 & 3 (1)


- The province intends to collaborate with the private sector (private practice Drs, Pharmacies, and private hospitals) to increase capacity for vaccination in these phases
- The dept mindful of the spread of COVID, will be approaching EC DoE to utilise 1800 - 2000 of its school buildings - when learners are not at school to vaccinate 35.5% of community members
- Professionally qualified staff (vaccinators) will perform the vaccinations
- There are 33 far flung rural / farm communities, some more than 50km from a HCF,
 wherein the dept will dispatch mobile units for vaccination in those sites
- Covid-19 protocols will be adhered to during the vaccination programme





PREPARATIONS – PHASE 2 & 3 (2)

- Location of the 5,414
 Vaccination Sites in the EC
- The relative size of the bubbles indicate the population sizes
- Smaller bubble = 2000 people
- Largest bubbles 10,000 people
- Bubble sizes are in increments of 500 people










PREPARATIONS – PHASE 2 & 3 (3)

- Red ". " is a PHC










VACCINATION PROGRAMME TIMELINES

Vaccine Rollout Timeframe





- Engagements with NDOH regarding adjusted roll-out strategy are ongoing
- Site Readiness visits & preparations have been conducted
- NMAH has been visited by the Premier & acting MEC on 19/02/21
- Action plans amended have been amended to take into account the change in vaccine administered in Phase 1
- Stakeholder roles and responsibilities have been developed and signed off including TOR
- 12 initial sites identified has been assessed and are ready (vaccinators are ready & site ready in terms of the NDOH assessment tool)
- WHO recommended Vaccination fridges have been procured (in the process of procuring WHO approved cooler boxes
- Frocurement of vaccination ancillary supplies has been done & these have been delivered to the initial 12 targeted
- vaccination sites of trained vaccinators for Phase 2 & 3
- SOPs and guidelines for vaccine supply and management have been distributed and staff orientated SOPs and Guidelines for implementation
- Assessment of storage capacity for vaccines has been conducted & there is adequate storage capacity for Phase 1 vaccines (more capacity is required for storage for phases 2 and 3
- Other cold chain items (ice packs, cold chain boxes, temperature loggers) are in the process of being procured





EASTERN CAPE PROGRESS UPDATE - WORKSTREAMS (2)

Information systems

- The EVDS version with the J&Js Vaccine details and linked Concent went live at 13h00, 17 Feb 21.
- The SMS to opt in has been sent to
 nation facing HCWs of the 2 Hospitals

Communication

Posters circulated: Myth debunk / Vaccine rollout plan / Vaccine benefits

- Vaccination information videos circulated
- Facebook live broadcasts have been undertaken
- Slots on Radio Stations secured
- A vaccination call centre is being set up to assist communities with information regarding vaccination

Human Systems

- HCW & Categorised Staff Lists have been finalised
- Non-Persal Data of HCWs is in progress NDOH / HISP assisting Provinces
- Vaccinator identification & training program has been fully implemented
- Data gathering with external stakeholders for 2nd phase ongoing OTP leading





CONCLUSION

- Vaccination programme of HCW is progressing well (albeit slow at NMAH site) at the 2
 provincial research sites & plans are in place to improve vaccination uptake
- Intersectoral collaboration & a multisectoral team approach across all levels of government in the province is critical in the successful roll out of the vaccine especially in relation to Phases 2 & 3
