Short leaning programs in parliamentary business


Short learning in soft skills such as public speaking and media handling

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PARLIAMENTARY INSTITUTE

- The Speakers Forum established the Parliamentary Institute of the Legislative Sector to drive capacitation of Sector through training, development and research.
