#### 1. Opening and welcoming

Mr Thembinkosi Ngoma, the Committee Secretary opened the meeting and welcomed everyone in attendance. He informed members that the meeting was the first for the Committee for Section 194 Enquiry and that the only agenda item was to elect a Chairperson, in terms of National Assembly Rule's 160 and 129AC.

#### 2. Election of Chairperson

Mr Ngoma outlined the election process to members and proceeded to call for nominations.

Ms Doris Eunice Dlakude nominated Mr Qubudile Richard Dyantyi. Mr Mondli Gungubele seconded the nomination of Mr Dyantyi. Mr Dyantyi accepted the nomination.

Mr Ngoma proceeded to call for further nominations. There were no further nominations. He declared Mr Qubudile Richard Dyantyi the elected Chairperson of the Committee for Section 194 Enquiry and invited him to take over the proceedings.

Mr Dyantyi accepted the huge responsibility and the privilege afforded to him to lead the Committee. He highlighted that the Committee was the first of its kind and the biggest the National Assembly has had. He indicated that his election as the Chairperson marked the beginning of the work of the Committee. He further shared the vision he had for the Committee to conduct its business. Mr Dyantyi emphasized that it was important that members had no predetermined outcomes of the work of the Committee and that all its work should be based on evidence and facts.

Members from various political parties welcomed the election of Mr Dyantyi as the Chairperson and expressed support for non-partisan engagements, based on procedural fairness. Members also emphasized the importance of the work of the Committee and that it was important to conduct itself, putting the interests of South Africans first. There was a request for an audited document by the Constitutional and Legal Services of reports released by Public Protector during her term of office, and which of those reports were reviewed in courts successfully or otherwise.

Mr Dyantyi allowed for the introduction of the support staff of the Committee, from various units of Parliament.

### **3. Adjournment**

The meeting adjourned at 10:50.
