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OPERATION VALA ZONKE

Aim of the Program

The programme was launched on the 8th August 2022 by the Minister of Transport. Vala Zonke is a labor-intensive programme to fix potholes throughout South Africa.

The rollout of this programme is the implementation of an integrated, rigorous and comprehensive plan that will drive interventions to ensure that the Department of Transport improves the overall condition index of roads at local and provincial authorities.

The progress to date can be classified as follows:

- 1. Work opportunities 80 (Gasegonyana Municipality CBD District Kuruman from 1 September 2022)
- 2. Achievement (2022/23) 3240.18m²
- 3. Targeted areas
 - 3.1 Provincial road network (JTG District)



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OPERATION VALA ZONKE(2023/24)

Current Financial –Various Roads in the District

- Total length of paved road network in JTG 486.23km
- Vala zonke Budget: R5 500 000
- Annual target 3500m²
- Achievement 2341.54m²
- Progress to date 67%
- Only internal teams utilised to carry out the works.
- Duration: April 2023 till March 2024.

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S'HAMBA SONKE PROGRAMME

PROJECT NAME: SIDE WALK PAVING IN BATLHAROS (PHASE 2)

The S'hamba Sonke Programme (Moving Together : Accelerating Rural Development Through Access and Mobility) specifically addresses the concern to address the ongoing deterioration of South Africa's secondary (provincial) road networks within a road construction and maintenance methodology that is both labour absorptive and meets the criteria of the Integrated Transport Sector Code (August 2009) and the Construction Sector Code (June 2009).

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S'HAMBA SONKE PROGRAMME

PROJECT NAME: SIDE WALK PAVING IN BATLHAROS (PHASE 2)

- This project consists of the paving of a 2km side walk (1.5m width) and it is located in close proximity of the Batlharos Hospital.
- Project Budget: R8 100 000
- The progress of this project is currently at 5%.
- 40 local people have been employed on the project.
- Duration: 8 Months Project.
- Under Contractor Development.



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Upgrade Project

PROJECT NAME: UPGRADING OF MAIN ROAD 947 BETWEEN RUSFONTEIN AND LAXEY – PHASE 3

- This project consists of the upgrading of a 12km gravel road to surface standard between Padstow and Laxey. This upgrading to surfaced standard will go through the Laxey village.
- Project Budget: R94 .3 Million
- The progress of this project is currently at 98%.
- 68 local people have been employed on the project.
